





Data security (54%) and new cloud-based solutions (52%) are the key areas of investment for IT departments in Europe this year. The UK (36%) and Germany (39%) regard managing software upgrades as their biggest challenge when managing multiple devices at scale.





Over 60% of businesses review their security strategy at least once a year, with one in five IT decision makers considering external cyber-attacks their biggest security risk in the UK and Germany, with viruses (22%) the key concern in France.

62% of staff across Europe said they use personal devices – including smartphones (42%) and tablets (31%) – to work remotely, so businesses are rightly considering security a priority.





Poor battery life (41%) is one of the main complaints from staff faced by senior IT decision makers. 81% of senior IT decision makers regard data security as a key priority.



Employees in IT departments (41%) are thought to be the most frequent perpetrators of unauthorised use of IT systems and solutions.
